You can do as many of these tasks as you like, but we expect you to complete at least one from each section by half term. We will share work every Friday afternoon in our classes.



History and the Arts

- Research a famous Elizabethan explorer and create a presentation on their discoveries e.g. Francis Drake, Walter Raleigh or perhaps John Hawkins?
- Design a Tudor Board game that helps the players to better understand one of the big events or series of events that occurred during Tudor times.
- Use the internet to explore Tudor diets and create a menu for either a Tudor feast in the Royal Palace or for a poor family on Christmas Day.
- Create a 5 minute lesson starter activity for your next Topic lesson that revisits one of the key ideas or events that we've covered so far this term.
- What was the Spanish Armada? Research the events that led up to this key event and produce a poster that explains what happened.



Science and IT

Research a famous scientist, who they were and what did they do.



English

- Interview someone older than 60 (family member, friend) what was life like for them as a child? What was different? The Same?
- Create a grammar revision poster to help you remember what a modal verb is, a preposition, proper noun, formal language, adverbial...etc.



Maths

- Complete an informative poster all about fractions which can be a revision tool.
- Create your own code breaking task for a friend to solve, such as what is the hidden message.
