Please complete 5 or more activities this term (minimum of one English and one Maths). It would be lovely to see some of your inventive work during our 'Show and Tell' time.

English

- Create a comic strip using some of the Viking Gods as characters.
- Learn a poem off by heart to share.
- Create a Viking character, giving them a name, interests, favourite food and 3 more interesting facts.

Maths

- Measure different parts of your body and compare your results to someone else in your family. Try to answer questions such as 'Who has longer arms?' or 'Who is taller?' Try to use one decimal place.
- Create some times table flashcards and use them to memorise (4s, 8s, 3s for Year 3 moving on to 6s, 8s, 9s for Year 4).
- Write 10 facts about you and your family using Roman numerals (i.e. how old you are, your house number).

History

- Complete some research into Alfred the Great – how is he linked to the Vikings and to Oxfordshire?
- Draw some pictures and write about your day if you were a Viking – What would you wear? Where would you live? Would you go to school?
- Create a 'Norse dictionary' including 10 words – which words were used by the Vikings that we still use today?

Science

- Create a piece of artwork or a poster that will help you to remember the names of some bones.
- Take some 'healthy selfies' to share with the class.
- Cook (and eat!) a healthy meal – take a picture to show us!

PE

- Build your fitness by completing the skipping challenge at least once a week (2 minutes).
- See how far you can run in 5 minutes – can you improve each week?
